BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Flossie Whipple Hagan was born in Pima, Arizona in 1894. She was the daughter of the William Whipple and Polly Ann Carter, Mormon pioneers in Utah. They settled in Clifton where William ran the Clifton Dairy. Flossie married Roy W. Hagan in 1913 and they lived in Douglas where he was general manager of the Phelps Dodge Mercantile Company. They later settled in Tucson.
