DESCRIPTION

This small collection consists of a ledger book with expenses & rental listings, and three folders of receipts for purchases associated with Mary Haworth and Chas J. Feldman. The ledger contains listings associated with a home in Willcox, AZ purchased by Mrs. Haworth on April 2, 1900. Names of renters appearing in the ledger include Mrs. O. M. Ada, Bill Richendson, Mr. Miller, and Mrs. J. E. Harris. In the back of the ledger appear several pages associated with the estate of Refugia Buca Morales including an expense listing for the estate and various items associated with it. Receipts appear to be associated with the upkeep and maintenance of the building.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

In addition of her association with the above identified rental property in Willcox, AZ in the early 20th century Mrs. Haworth was involved with a property dispute in Tucson, AZ in 1947. In Feb legal proceedings were conducted to remove her from a home at 908 North First Avenue. Chas J. Feldman formally owned the house. Mrs. Haworth had been allowed to live in the structure until the city took possession of the structure in 1945 and ordered her removed. At the time she was ordered out of the house on Feb. 7, 1947 she was reported as being 67 years old. No additional information on Mrs. Haworth has been located.
