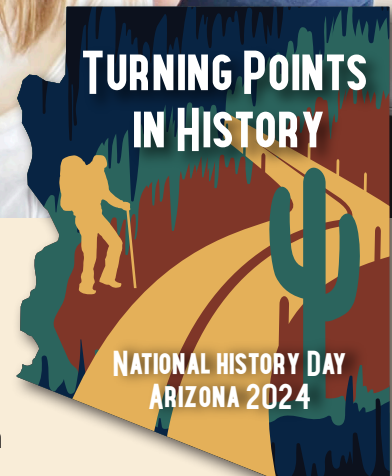


National History Day in Arizona

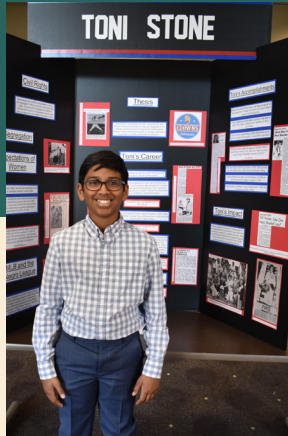

Workshops
