**GRANJON, HENRY, 1863-1922**  
**Papers, 1878-79**

**DESCRIPTION**

One exercise book, kept by Henry Granjon as a student in 1878. Written in French, it appears to be an exercise book in which Granjon copied articles written by others. Subjects include "Les hommes apres le deluge," "Chant du roi Gilmer," and "Arthur de Richemont." The collection includes one bound exercise book (125 pages) and a photocopy of the original.

**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Henry Regis Granjon, Bishop of Tucson, was born and educated in France. He was ordained in 1886 and was sent to Arizona in 1890, where he was assigned as assistant pastor in Tombstone. After serving in Tombstone, he was appointed as Bishop of Tucson in 1900. He died while visiting Europe in 1922.
