DESCRIPTION

Prospectus, stock certificates, letters about stock transfers, and three photographs of the mine and miners' camp, ca. 1916-1918. The stock certificates were issued to Dorothy Overfield and the letters request the transfer of stock to Frederick Overfield. The photographs show a mine entrance, a distant view of the driller's dwellings, and a landscape view.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Great Ray Copper Company was a company with mining claim holdings at Ray, Arizona. J.J. Hurlbert, of Los Angeles, was the financial agent. A prospectus, dated 1916, was issued to entice investors in the new company. Since it is not mentioned in a history of Ray, Arizona, copper operations, it may not have been successful.
