BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Francis J. Green, priest and bishop of Tucson, grew up in Prescott, Arizona before attending a seminary at Menlo Park, California. After being ordained in 1932, he came to Tucson and spent the rest of his life here. In 1953, he was made auxiliary bishop and in 1960 was installed as bishop of the diocese. He retired in 1981 and died in Tucson in 1995.
