BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Mary Lucille Hathaway, pioneer Santa Cruz ranch women, came to Arizona as an infant, where her parents settled in the religious community of Sunnsyside. In 1914, she married William H. Hathway and together they homesteaded a cattle ranch east of Nogales. William Hatahway was a state senator for many years.
