# MS 930 HAWLEY, FRED GRAHAM, 1875?-1962 HAWLEY PAPERS, 1902-1939

Fred Graham Hawley was chief chemist at the Cananea Consolidated Copper Company in Sonora from 1902 to 1913, chief chemist at International Smelting Company in Miami, Arizona from 1914 until his retirement in 1946 and consultant chemist for the U. S. Bureau of Mines from 1948 to 1953 in Tucson. He was the author of a volume on analytical methods of chemistry and many articles on the subject.
