DESCRIPTION

Biographical information on Mabel Ruth Jackson and a manuscript biography of Marilla Merriman Guild, a teacher who came to Tucson in 1897 and later taught in Bisbee, Arizona. Also includes poems by both Jackson and Merriman and a manuscript entitled *History of the Rimers Club of Tucson, Arizona* written by Jackson in 1956. Collection also includes a "Union Defender's Certificate" in the name of Edward Anderson, father of Mrs. Jackson, dated 1864.

Mabel Ruth Jackson came to Arizona from Chicago in 1934. She wrote stories, newspaper and magazine articles and poetry. She was a member of the Tucson Rimers and the Tucson Writers Club.
