DESCRIPTION

This collection consists of newspaper articles, mostly authored by Opie Rundle Burgess, written for the *Bisbee Daily Review* from 1956 to 1958. The articles are about Bisbee and southern Arizona history featuring people, events, and locations including topics such as mines and mining, Mrs. John Campbell, a city 4th of July celebration, Jack Stillman, and the Copper Queen Mine. Three additional articles authored by Burgess, which appeared in *Arizona Highways*, are also present.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Opie Rundle Burgess Lea came to the mining camp in Bisbee Arizona with her parents Richard and Florence Rundle in 1882. She attended Oberlin College and married Ivan Burgess. With her mother's help Opie started recording the local history and providing stories to the local paper, *Bisbee Daily Review* in a column titled "Trail Blazers."
