Carbon typescript of diary covering Feb. 6, 1849 to Aug. 24, 1849 of an unknown person's journey from Logansport to southern California. Mentions encounters with Apache and Pima Indians.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Attorney and publisher of the *Canal Telegraph* in Logansport, Indiana; he left his law practice to visit California during the Gold Rush.
