The group includes Dan Williamson, Edith Kitt, Frank Lockwood, John Rockfellow, Joe McKinney, George Wise, Edwin B. Hill, Father Bonaventure Oblasser, Bernice Cosulich, and Bob Hayden. The tour includes Courtland and Gleeson, Arizona, a Tombstone school and Wells Fargo office, and the ruins of the Butterfield stage station at Dragoon, Ariz.
