There are images of unidentified family and friends, Tucson homes, a picnic, an excursion to the Arizona State Prison, and interior and exterior views of the OK Grocery at 544 S. 3rd Avenue. There is also an image of a grocer washing vegetables in back of the store.

Ban Sing, a resident of Tucson from 1913 until his death on October 24, 1970, owned and operated the OK Grocery at 544 S. 3rd Avenue. He had two children, Edward Ban and Margaret Ban (Mrs. William Wong).
