BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Nelson Bledsoe, physician, was born in California in 1876. He graduated from the California State Normal School along with his future wife, Harriet B. Gage in 1896. After teaching several years in the public schools, he entered the University of Southern California Medical School. After receiving his degree in 1903, he interned at L. A. County Hospital for a year and in 1904, moved to Bisbee, Arizona to work as the company doctor for the Calumet Mining Company. He married Harriet Gage on August 9, 1906. He became chief surgeon in 1910 and worked at oversaw the building of the Calumet Hospital. He was an active member of the community in Bisbee, joining the Masons, the Elks and was the first president of the Bisbee Boy Scout Council in 1922. When the mining companies merged in 1931, he moved to Tucson where he opened a new practice. He became more involved with his Masonic work and eventually achieved the highest office in Masonry in Arizona. He retired at the end of 1948, however he continued to practice out of his home until 1955. In 1949, he was elected President of the Arizona Pioneers' Historical Society and served until 1957. His wife died in 1962; Nelson died in 1974.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The bulk of the collection consists of photographs of Bisbee, Arizona from the turn of the century to the 1930s. There are mining photographs as well as street scenes and views. The collection includes many photographs (both exterior and interior) of the Calumet and Arizona Hospital, built in Bisbee and supervised by Nelson Bledsoe. These would be of value to someone researching hospital construction and outfitting. The collection also includes portraits of Bledsoe and photographs of his homes in Bisbee and Tucson.
