Photographs of the Brown and Winsor families and their activities in Tucson, Sahuarita Ranch, and Yuma, Arizona. There are family picnics, tennis, and groups at Sahuarita Ranch. There are images of Clara Brown in the kitchen, playing tennis, and more. Photographs of Mulford Winsor include a 1919 school group at Shadyside School in Yuma, making cascarones for a children's party, and the interior of a Prescott newspaper shop. Images of the Brown home at 422 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue are also present.

**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Pioneer rancher and Pima County sheriff; Brown married Olive Letitia Stephenson in 1879 and they moved to Sahuarita where they ran the Sahuarita Ranch as a stagecoach station and post office until 1890. Their daughter, Clarissa Brown, married Mulford Winsor.
