**Mining cyanotype photographs, ca. 1895-1910**

**DESCRIPTION**

Cyanotype photographs, some glued into an album, of the mining activities of John Campbell. Most of the images are not identified; while others are identified as Fairview, British Columbia, and locations in Yavapai and Mohave County, Arizona. Some of the photographs were taken in Mexico. There are also images of Rich Hill Mining Co. equipment, the Kingman, Arizona court house, and the Yarnell Mine in Prescott. Scenes include mining equipment, mine buildings, towns and landscapes relating to mines, miners, and gatherings of men, women and children.
