BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Thomas E. Campbell was the first native born Arizonan to be elected governor. Campbell was born on the grounds of Fort Whipple on January 18, 1878. Campbell grew up in Prescott and later became a mining engineer. On June 8, 1900, Campbell married Eleanor Gayle Allen in Jerome, Arizona. They had two sons, Allen and Brodie.

In 1900, Campbell was elected to the Arizona legislature and was the youngest member of the 1901 House of Representatives. The most important proposal Campbell submitted was to limit underground miners to an eight hour day. The bill passed the House but was not adopted in the Council.

In the years following his return to work in the legislature, Campbell was postmaster of Jerome, agent for the Yavapai Indians, and worked locating mining sites. Eventaully the Campbells moved to Prescott. Campbell was selected as Yavapai County Assessor .Campbell was narrowly elected Governor in 1916 and was inaugurated in January 1917, but that December, the States Supreme Court ruled that George W.P. Hunt was the rightful claimant to office. In 1918 and 1920 he was elected Governor and served from January 1919 to January 1923. In 1922, Campbell was defeated again for reelection by Hunt. He ran again in 1936 and was defeated by R.C. Stanford.

In his later years, Campbell made his home in Phoenix, and died there in 1944.
