Norman Wallace photographs, ca. 1930-1950

DESCRIPTION

A few photographs of Arizona scenic views, some black-and-white and two color, taken by Norman Wallace between 1930 and 1950. The two colored images were oil-tinted by Norman's wife, Henrietta Wallace. The views include two images of aspens in the San Francisco Peaks printed to look like photo engravings, an image of Canyon Lake and a colored image of a flowering saguaro cactus.
