DESCRIPTION

This small collection consists of two small photo albums with images from the Tucson and Phoenix areas. Most of the photographs appear to have been taken around 1910 or 1920. Subjects depicted include the state capital building, Adams Hotel, and the old courthouse building all in Phoenix. Tucson images show University of Arizona buildings and grounds including Old Main, the cactus garden, Herring Hall, and the University Library. A number of photos in both albums show trips to a rocky canyon (Sabino Canyon?) and ostriches. Numerous photos show men in vests and suit coats and women with large hats and long dresses of the times.

From the back of one photograph Margaret Eldred is identified as being born in Kalamazoo, MI on Dec. 1, 1882 and died June 25, 1968 in Tampa, FL. From note sheets with the collection it indicates that Margaret may have come from Minot, N.D. and taught music. No listings for her under Eldred have been located in Tucson City Directories or in University of Arizona yearbooks.
