DESCRIPTION

This small photo album consists of photographs in and around Tucson Arizona with a few images from the border area of Nogales and Mexico. Images from Tucson depict a visit to San Xavier Mission, Sabino Canyon, a Tucson High School building, and the University of Arizona fountain and Old Main building. Additional photographs show Yaqui Indians dancing, the Nogales railroad station, Mexican children, and street scenes at Guaymas, Mexico. Approximately half of the images have captions although difficult to read.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Geraldine (Sampson) Fenollosa was a student at Tucson High School when she took the images contained in this album. She graduated in 1921 having recently transferred from Washington Ohio. After 1922 her name (Sampson) disappears from the Tucson city directories and only reappears (as Fenollosa) in 1986. Her correspondence with the Historical Society for the donation is 1987 and after that date her name again disappears from the city directories. No obituary or additional information has been located.
