One small photograph album and loose photo album pages with images of mining activities, workers, and camps relating to the work at the San Xavier Mine, Helmet Peak Mine in Pima County, Arizona and Llano, Sonora, Mexico. Images show L. H. Jansen, T. Carl Jansen, the railroad station at Llano, desert mining activities, adobe buildings, beds for sleeping outside, and Mexican and African American mine workers.
