DESCRIPTION

A small collection of photographs, taken by Jack Sheaffer, of the area south of Congress about 1970. Most images are birds-eye-views probably taken from the newly completed Pima County government complex. There are interior photographs of the Legal Tender Bar just prior to its demolition in 1969. Other photographs show the gradual demolition of existing homes and businesses from West Congress south to 14th Street, between Convent and S. Main Avenue.
