**Palmer, Edward, 1831-1911**  
**Papers, 1866-1872**

**DESCRIPTION**

Includes one handwritten manuscript entitled *Notes on the Pueblo Indians of New Mexico, 1869* written by Palmer. Also includes a typescript of his notes on Papago Indians. Original reports and correspondence cover Palmer's military experience in Arizona and describe an attack by Apaches en route from Fort Whipple to Camp Verde in 1871.

**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Edward Palmer served in the U. S. Army during the Civil War as acting Assistant Surgeon. After the war, he was stationed at various posts, including Fort Whipple in Arizona. He was also a botanist and amateur anthropologist.
