**HISTORICAL NOTE:** This collection examines the role of C.O.S.T.S (Citizens Opposing Senseless Transportation Schemes), a grassroots organization founded by James A. Vivian, a retired engineer and resident of Phoenix. C.O.S.T.S effectively opposed funding for certain highway construction that potentially threatened hundreds of residents physically and financially. They solicited political support from many other like-minded community groups, individual citizens, public officials and neighborhoods. They held the position that these highway proposals would not only cost more than was originally budgeted, but also would not have the desired outcomes predicted by government officials. Moreover, James Vivian feared that Phoenix would become another Los Angeles due to poor transportation planning.

C.O.S.T.S led a pitched battle against Proposition 300 intended to fund the construction of the Paradise Parkway. It was to run through highly developed and densely populated areas, travelling from Loop 101 between Camelback Road and Glendale Avenue, then east to Interstate 17 and ultimately to Arizona Route 51. Facing stiff public resistance coupled with a funding shortfall, plans for the Paradise Parkway were cancelled. It remains a 'dead' project today with no efforts to resuscitate it. This collection documents a tense decade from 1987 to 1996, between government officials and taxpayers as well as the strategies and resources used by both sides to make their case.

**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:** Documents the strategies of a successful grassroots campaign blocking the development of the Paradise Parkway. Provides a comprehensive collection of state, county and city transportation planning materials many of which are hard-to-find or unavailable. Illustrates the complex issues balancing urban growth and development with the wants and needs of neighborhoods affected by freeway construction.

This collection is arranged in five series. **Series I: COSTS** – memos, correspondence, minutes, materials generated by Citizens Opposing Senseless Transportation Schemes  
**Series II: Government** – agencies, commissions, and appointed committees tasked with planning, development, oversight, or advisory responsibilities related to freeway construction. **III: Publications** – technical reports, studies, guidelines, master plans regarding urban transportation collected by COSTS. **IV: Media** - News clippings relating to transportation, urban growth and development, op-ed columns, letters to editor, and news items following various perspectives of the issues; brochures and pamphlets; photographs. **Series V: Oversize** – maps, drawings, engineering plans and proposals related to Paradise Freeway.
