DESCRIPTION

Documents from the Pinal County District Court. The bulk of the documents pertain to the estate of John D. Walker (deceased) from 1892-1894. Walker was the owner of the Vekol Mine in Pinal County. The proceedings include testimony from William H. Walker, A. J. Doran, L. C. Hughes, Mrs. E. J. Hughes, Dr. T. H. Sabin and Dr. James J. Choate. Other cases included in the collection are Peter R. Brady vs. Florence Canal Company and Bertha Tomlinson vs. Southern Pacific Railroad.

HISTORICAL NOTE

Pinal County was formed from parts of Maricopa and Pima Counties in 1875. In 1877, the county was modified slightly to correct a boundary error and it lost the Globe District to Gila County in 1881. The county seat is Florence. The Vekol mine, located on the Tohono O'odham reservation southwest of Casa Grande, operated between 1885 and 1916. The silver mine was run by John D. Walker and Peter R. Brady.
