DESCRIPTION

Research and seminar papers relating to the photography of George J. Roskruge and other photographers in Arizona circa 1880 to 1895. Includes seminar papers about early photography in Arizona including papers about photographers Henry Buchman, William P. Haynes, F.A. Hartwell, and Rev. George H. Adams. Also present is biographical research about George Roskruge, pioneer surveyor and amateur photographer, and research into his photographs in the Arizona Historical Society collections. There are also card indexes arranged by date and by name which contain citations to newspaper articles about Tucson photographers between 1879 and 1899.
