DESCRIPTION

The Pueblo Junior Woman's Club Collection consists of by-laws, yearbooks with activities and member listings, newsletters, and scrapbooks featuring activities from 1950-1980. Of special note are the two scrapbooks containing newspaper clippings, programs, and activity listings for the organization from the first two years after it became a separate group 1950-1951. There are also reports and ephemera for a variety of community projects during the 1970s.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Tucson Junior Woman's Club of Tucson is one of the city's oldest service organizations. An offshoot of the Tucson Woman's Club, it has existed in Tucson since 1928. In 1950 two separate clubs were formed with the new club known as the Pueblo Junior Woman's Club. The objective of the organization is to maintain an organized focus of study, recreation, training for citizenship, social development, and to equip young women for service to the community. The organization participates in various community fund-raising drives including Community Chest, Red Cross, and Polio. Recreational activities included a yearly fashion show and Mistletoe Ball in December. The Mistletoe Ball was later discontinued and replaced with a sponsored golf tournament.
