BACKGROUND NOTE

The archaeological project came as a result of a proposed strip mining development proposal for the northern portion of the Santa Rita Mountains by Anamax Mining Company. An assessment was required to evaluate and identify cultural resources required under the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and later legislation. In 1970 actual survey work began by the Arizona State Museum and work was completed in 1979. Centuries Research, Inc. was employed to make final evaluations of the historical resources located through the survey.
