DESCRIPTION

Miscellaneous court records from Santa Cruz County, Ariz. Includes Washington Precinct Justice of the Peace's office criminal complaints and warrants for arrest, 1899-1902 and documents from three cases: A. Steinfeld & Co. vs. Wing Wong, 1912, Roy & Titcomb vs. Thomas Park, et.al., 1915, and Robinsons Cattle Co. vs. Cornelius Watts, et.al., 1918-1919. John H. Campbell was the attorney in the last case. The Justice of the Peace records involve offenses such as disturbing the peace, larceny and assault.

Santa Cruz County, Arizona was created in March 1899 from parts of Pima and Cochise Counties. Washington was an early day mining camp.
