DESCRIPTION

Biographical materials and documents from the Shibell family in Tucson. Includes family genealogy, wedding and funeral announcements, a scrapbook, and small amount of family correspondence. The scrapbook was put together by Mercedes Shibbell Gould and particularly documents a 50-year University of Arizona class reunion. Of particular interest is one ledger kept by Charles Shibbell from 1887 to 1890 which includes grand jury trials, accounts and records of bonds.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Mercedes Shibell Gould donated the collection of family materials. Mercedes was the daughter of Charles Shibell, early-day sheriff of Pima County. She was one of the first graduates of the University of Arizona. She was widowed twice as a young woman; first by Harry M. Greene and then by Dr. Alexander Gould. She was a member of the board of the Arizona Pioneers' Historical Society for many years and was active with the YWCA.
