DESCRIPTION

Membership records of 28 members of the Sons of Veterans U.S.A., Gen. R. H. G. Minty Camp (Tucson, Ariz.), California Division, dated 1902. All members resided in Tucson. Information given includes name, age, birthplace, residence and occupation and father's name and brief record of Civil War service. A name index is included. Members include Kirt L. Hart, Kirk Moore, and George H. Smalley.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Sons of Veterans was created by the Grand Army of the Republic (Union Veterans of the Civil War) in 1881 to carry on its traditions and memory through the descendants of those who served with the Union in the United States Civil War. In 1925, the organization's name was changed to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War.
