- 1693, 1702 Two photostats documents signed by Joseph Augustin Campos, Minister of Doctrine for his Majesty. One tells of death and burial of Father Francisco Gonsalvo, 1702; the other tells of uprising of the Indians and destruction of papers of administration, 1693. Copied from Bancroft Library.
- 1711 Photostat copy of Father Kino's burial record and translation, 1711.
- 1738-1755 Photostat copies of Visita records, Jesuit baptismal records for the towns of visitation, San Pedro and Santa Cruz River valleys, Santa Cruz, Sonora, Mexico (formerly Santa María de Suamca), 1738-1755. Copied from the Bancroft Library.
- 1743-1768 Photostat copies of Mission records, Jesuit baptismal and marriage records. Santa Cruz, Sonora, Mexico, (formerly Santa María de Suamca), 1743-1768. Copied from the Bancroft Library.
- 1761? Photostat of document telling of the death of Father Gaspar Stiger, signed by Francisco Pauer, ca. 1761. Copied from the Bancroft Library. Copy and translation made by Henry Dobyns.
- 1770 Photostat typescript "Descripcion de las Provincias de Culiacan, Sinaloa, and Sonora, by Fersén, 1770.
- 1762, 1782 Typescript of documents from Archivo General de Indias, Seville. Report on mission at Tucson and the Pima, Papago, Apache and Sobaipuri Indians. Appt. of Josef de Castro to be Alferez of the Presidio of San Agustin del Tucson, 1762 and 1782
- 1780 Burial record at Magdalena, signed by Fray Pedro Arriquibar, 1780, 2 pages. Copied from Bancroft Library.
- 1776 Photostat of page from Magdalena burial register, telling of depredations of the Seri and Pima Indians committed upon pueblo of Santa Maria Magdalena, signed by Pedro Font, Nov. 16, 1776. Copied from Bancroft Library.

- 1790 Photocopy of last will and testament of Miguel Gerónimo Elías Gonzalez, dated 1790; includes a detailed inventory of his possessions. It refers to Arizpe as the provincial capitol.
- 1796, 1820 Photostat of marriage and baptismal register from the Mission del Costisimo Patriaxca San Jose del Tumacacori for the year 1796, and inventory of Compania del Tucson, 1820.
- 1822-1854 Photocopies of original documents in Spanish and translations. Instrument of titles for San José de Sonoita, San Rafael de la Zanja, San Ygnacio del Babocamari, Fort of Tubac, Maria Santisima del Carmen, Tres Alamos, El Paso de los Algodones, and Terrante Land Grants

- 1731-1783 Photocopies of documents from the General Archives of the Indies, Guadalajara concerning Spanish presidios including appointments to office, dismissals, inspections many from or relating to the Presidio of Tubac and Hugo O'Connor and documents from the General Archives of the Indies, Seville many relating to Joseph Antonio Vildosola.
