STYLES, WILLIAM SAMUEL, 1850-1943

DESCRIPTION

This collection consists of two folders of biographical information concerning William Samuel Styles who was a supply Sergeant at Fort Lowell between 1885—1889. The first folder contains military records of Styles. This folder includes a handwritten letter which is an application to renew his army position. The second folder contains an Arizona Historical Society biographical form filled out by his son, Stanton Styles and a sympathy letter from the Veteran's administration to Marian Styles, one of Styles' children.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

William Styles was born in Plymouth, England in 1850. He emigrated to the United States in 1880, married Mary Maxwell in New York and joined the Army in 1883. He served in the army at various western outposts until 1901. He entered the Postal Service in New York City and retired from that in 1920. He died in 1943.
