DESCRIPTION

One folder of miscellaneous papers from Rebecca Sutherland. The most significant document is an agreement between the Fort Mohave Indians and the Cotton Land Company concerning land use in 1930 on property in Mohave County in 1940. Includes a letter of condolence from Governor Sidney Osborn to Mrs. Sutherland on the death of her husband in 1947. Also includes a criminal subpoena to Mrs. Sutherland in a 1940 case of Arizona vs. Charles Eaton. Notices of mining locations for "White Cloud Mines" in Mohave County (1929) belong to Mrs. Sutherland are included.

Rebecca Sutherland was the wife of Charles Guy Sutherland, who was ranch manager for the Cotton Land Cattle Company, on the Arizona side of the Colorado river in Mohave County.
