**Thomas-Davis Clinic collection, 1929 – 1991**

**DESCRIPTION**

Articles, newspaper clippings, certificates and photographs about the Thomas-Davis Clinic and the people involved, such as the Thomas brothers and other doctors, and construction planning for the buildings. Also, there are plaques and certificates of achievement for the family members and partners in the clinic. The clinic itself was a joint project by two prominent men, Dr. C. A. Thomas and Dr. S. C. Davis. Photographs include images of the doctors, and building construction and groundbreaking ceremonies in 1960, and a later eastside building at 9302 E. 22<sup>nd</sup> St.

**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

The two men, who had both studied Medicine in Oklahoma, originally organized the Thomas-Davis Clinic in 1920. Beginning on Pennington Street in Tucson and spreading across Arizona, the clinic became a symbol of Tucson's progress since the 1920's. The clinic itself had grown to a 34-physician clinic with a variety of specialties such as internal medicine, surgery, hematology, cardiology, allergy, Dermatology and many other specializations.
