HISTORICAL NOTE

The Tucson Child Guidance Clinic was started in 1953 with \$6,000 in seed money from the Junior League of Tucson. The clinic, located at 455 E. 6th Street, ran from 1953 through 1956 funded by a combination of private contributions, federal funds and fees. It became part of the Community Chest in 1956.
