According to the Tucson City Directory for 1903/04, The Tucson Grocer Company was owned by Julius Goldbaum and Gustave Hoff. They were wholesale and retail dealers in groceries, liquors, cigars and tobaccos, delicatessen and were located at 19-25 S. Stone Avenue.
