DESCRIPTION

A typewritten manuscript by Lorenzo Walters which was later published as *Tombstone's Yesterdays* in 1928. The manuscript includes handwritten changes. The book is a collection of articles on criminals and law enforcement in the Southwest. It includes articles on Tom Horn, Pat Garrett, Apache Kid, John Slaughter, Pearl Hart, Billy the Kid, the Yuma Penitentiary, Billy Brazelton, Curly Bill Brocius, the Earps and others. Walters published *Tombstone's Yesterdays* in 1928 after the articles appeared serially in *Progressive Arizona and the Southwest*.

Lorenzo D. Walters, peace officer and author, was interested in criminals of Arizona and the Southwest. He worked as a peace officers and was employed by the Santa Fe Railroad and the joined the Tucson police force in 1924. He died in Tucson in 1943.
