DESCRIPTION

Typescripts of dispatches by Wilke to the Arizona Daily Star concerning activities of the Arizona Legislature of interest to Pima County, from January to March 1925. Topics include child labor, Postvale farmers, the Colorado River Compact, uniform weights of loaves of bread, rights of medical schools to obtain bodies of executed prisoners, and a tribute to Bessie Golze, chief clerk of the House of Representatives.

Journalist and newspaper publisher; Al Wilke was the first staff correspondent sent from the Arizona Daily Star to report on the Arizona Legislature on a daily basis. He was later a publisher of the Coolidge News.
