**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Phoebe Bogan, author, teacher and Arizona pioneer, came to Arizona as a child. She supervisor of Spanish at Tucson High School and author of many articles and books on Indians of the Southwest including *The Yaqui Indian Dances* published in 1926. She died in Tucson in 1927.
