Museum/AHS update: David Breeckner, Executive Director:

- David welcomed everyone back and gave background information on himself and his mission in his role within AHS.
- Update was provided on the hiring of staff at Pioneer seven people have been offered the
 position of Operations Manager and all have declined with salary and cost of living being the
 greatest barriers. Discussion was held by all with various suggestions. Gwen suggested a
 partnership with the City of Flagstaff for a "gateway to the Grand Canyon" visitor center might
 be possible. Marilyn noted it might be helpful to offer an informational packet to applicants in
 the beginning of the conversation to help them understand Flagstaff.

- Discussion was held on the legislative budget and how the additional funds were used.
- AHS is sending staff up to open the museum two or three days a week. Discussion was held on how to promote the "open days" and how volunteers might be utilized to help with answering questions about Flagstaff and local history.
- David outlined several of the projects being done in and around the museum. Tom Rose provided additional information on projects in progress and supplies that have already been purchased. Tom noted that much of the work can be done with volunteers. It was suggested that a small committee put together a list of needs. Suggested members are Tom Rose, Pat Loven and Joe Meehan.
- David gave an update on the artifacts and will continue to provide information on deaccessioning.
- David gave an update on his work to streamline budgets and restrict funds more transparently.

Introduction of Kyle Morey, Development Director

- Kyle is excited to raise funds for the Arizona Historical Society.
- Members cautioned that Flagstaff donors want to be certain their dollars stay in Flagstaff.
- Members suggested that fundraising in Flagstaff is not appropriate until Pioneer Museum is staffed and open regularly, without interruption.
- Kyle will continue to communicate and work with members on the best path forward.
