**PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION:** This collection spans two map cases and includes 14 drawers of individually listed posters, with folders used for smaller ephemera.

**PROVENANCE:** Items in this collection have been accumulated from a variety of sources over the course of AHS history. Many of them were transferred from other collections, while other items have been received as single donations.

**RESTRICTIONS ON USE:** Requests for permission to publish material from this collection should be addressed to Arizona Historical Society, Library & Archives.

**PROCESSED BY:** Dena McDuffie processed this collection in January 2002. It was updated by intern Tory Bellavance in 2019, then reprocessed by Perri Pyle in 2023.

**HISTORICAL NOTE:** “Broadsides” refers to a promotion on any size sheet that is printed on one or both sides. Broadsides are often quickly and crudely produced and distributed for free, meant to have an immediate popular impact and then to be thrown away. Historically, broadsides have been used to inform the public about news, publicize official proclamations and government decisions, announce entertainment events, advocate for political and social causes, advertise products and services, and celebrate popular literary and musical efforts.

## **SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:**

The collection consists of business cards, brochures, bumper stickers, posters, flyers, and playbills. This collection is arranged topically and has been divided into four series:

### Series I: Political

- Drawer 1: Campaign Ephemera (flyers, leaflets, business cards)
- Drawer 2: Tucson/Pima County Politics
- Drawer 3: Arizona Politics
- Drawer 4: Activism (environment, labor, criminal cases, etc)

### Series II: Business

### Series III: Arts & Entertainment

- Drawer 8: Arizona Entertainment
